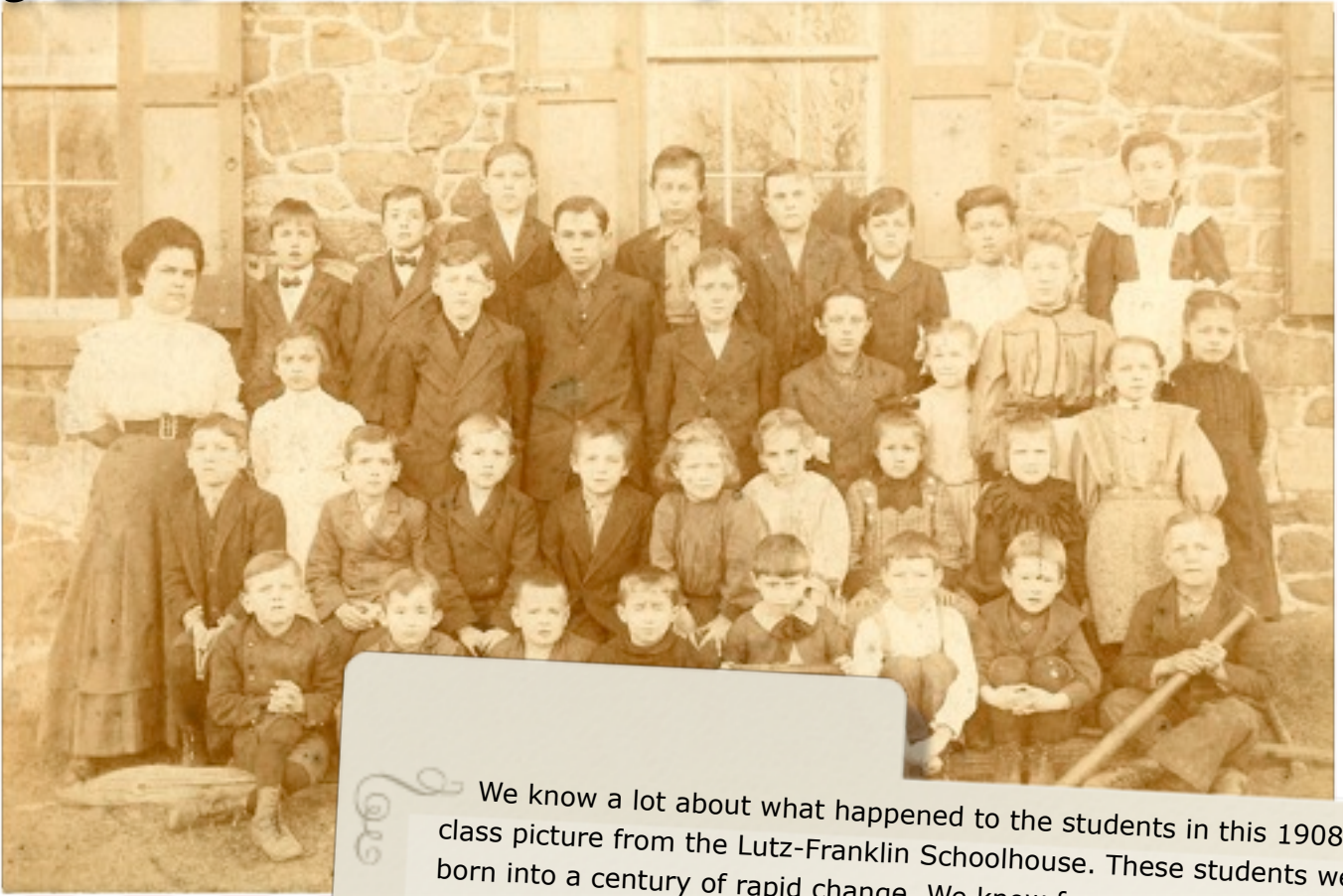

We know a lot about what happened to the students in this 1908 class picture from the Lutz-Franklin Schoolhouse. These students were born into a century of rapid change. We know from census reports they were lured from their family farms to employment in the local mills by the security of a steady wage. They married, had children and stayed in the Lehigh Valley. We know from World War I and II draft cards and other military records that the boys grew up to be patriotic and brave men. We know from social security records that they worked hard and we know when they died. But those facts are just the framework of their lives. Five Saucon Valley High School students, from Mr. Mario Marcozzi's *Twentieth Century American History* class, have attempted to go beyond these facts and envision the lives of the pictured students.

Another group of Saucon Valley High School students worked with our book collection in the Lower Saucon Township Historical Society archives. This was tedious but very important work. On **Wednesday, June 10th**, both groups will share their research, impressions and interpretations of these historical items.
